暑校课程审核已经开始，校园大使总结了审核课程的信息供大家参考，实际审核流程可能会因学院不同略有变化，请大家尽早审核课程，以免错过暑校申报时间。同学有最终的责任确认转学分政策，完成转学分流程。AUIA 只负责课程推广和学生活动等服务性工作，暑期课程教学及成绩单管理工作均由主办大学负责。因此，递交课程审核如需说明暑校名称，请按校区说明申请的是 xx 大学国际暑期学校，如国立台湾科技大学暑期学校等。

6 步转学分流程：

Step1 登陆官网 www.auiaschool.com 查看需要上的 AUIA 课程，下载课程描述及课程大纲。

Step2 登陆学校官网 <https://peabody.vanderbilt.edu/admin-offices/oas/downloads.php> 找到 Studying elsewhere/abroad and credit transfer 下载 Study elsewhere 文件，填写有关的课程信息以及个人资料。

Step3 带着 syllabus 和 Study Elsewhere 表格到课程相对应的部门找 department director 签字。

Step4 拿到课程的签字以后，把表格交回到 Office of Academic Services。地址：211Peabody Administration Building。暑期项目申请截止时间是 4 月 15 日。

Step5 暑假去 AUIA 国际暑期学校上课，成绩达 C-或者 C-以上可以转学分。

Step6 课程结束后，成绩单会从 AUIA 举办暑期课程的大学直接寄送到 Peabody Office of Academic Services。

Important note regarding ALL coursework taken elsewhere (except Pre-Freshman credit):

If you want to receive transfer credit for coursework taken at another institution, you must receive approval in advance from the appropriate academic department(s). Course approval must be done on the Study Elsewhere form, found here. You assume the risk of the failure to receive prior approval. All coursework, even if you just need it for hours toward graduation, must be approved. Departments are under no obligation to approve any course for transfer credit, and their decisions will be final.

If you attempt to seek approval after you have already completed the course, you will be required to submit a petition to the Undergraduate Administrative Committee before course evaluations can be done. If the UAC denies your request, you will not be able to seek credit for the courses you've taken.

Contact the Office of Academic Services for a list of course evaluators in each department.

SEMESTER ABROAD WORK AT ANOTHER INSTITUTION:

Students enrolled in Peabody College may receive credit for a maximum of 15 hours during all total semesters studied elsewhere. Application deadlines are: November 15 for the spring semester, June 15 for the fall semester.

The student must be in good standing and have at least a 2.7 cumulative GPA at the time of application.

Institution must be fully accredited.

Institution may NOT be a 2-year/community college.

The student may not travel through a program that is already offered through the Vanderbilt Global Education Office.

Transfer courses may not be part of the student's final 24 hours at Vanderbilt.

Transfer courses may be used to satisfy Liberal Education Core requirements with no more than one transfer course in any single Core area (e.g., if you need 2 science courses in your Liberal Core, you may take 1 of them elsewhere).

Transfer courses may be used to satisfy any major/minor requirements.

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Grades do not transfer into Vanderbilt as number/letter grades. They will appear as "T" on the transcript, and will not factor in your GPA. However, in order for a grade to transfer, you must make at least a C- and cannot have taken it Pass/Fail.

SUMMER COURSE WORK AT ANOTHER INSTITUTION:

Students enrolled in Peabody College may receive credit for a maximum of 12 hours during summers at another fully accredited four-year institution. Application deadline is April 15.

The following conditions must be met to obtain pre-approval to take summer course work elsewhere and complete the transfer of credit process:

The student must be in good standing and have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application.

Institution must be fully accredited.

Institution may NOT be a 2-year/community college.

The student may not travel through a program that is already offered through the Vanderbilt Global Education Office.

Transfer courses may not be part of the student's final 24 hours at Vanderbilt.

Transfer courses may be used to satisfy Liberal Education Core requirements with no more than one transfer course in any single Core area (e.g., if you need 2 science courses in your Liberal Core, you may take 1 of them elsewhere).

Grades do not transfer into Vanderbilt as number/letter grades. They will appear as "T" on the transcript, and will not factor in your GPA. However, in order for a grade to transfer, you must make at least a C- and cannot have taken it Pass/Fail.

CREDIT FOR PREVIOUS COLLEGE WORK (Pre-Freshmen Credit)

Entering freshmen who have taken pre-freshmen college work during their junior or senior year in high school or during summers prior to their offer of admission to Vanderbilt may be able to transfer that credit. Appropriate documentation, including course descriptions and syllabi must be submitted to the Peabody Office of Academic Services for evaluation and approval by the appropriate Vanderbilt departments. The question of credit for previous college work must be settled in advance of the student's first semester of classes.

In addition please have each institution from which you want to receive pre-freshmen credit verify that they meet the University's requirements for transfer credit using the Transfer Credit Institution Verification

Credit will be awarded only if:

The course is regularly offered by an accredited two-year or four-year college or university

If the teacher was a regular faculty member of that institution, and

If a majority of the students in the course were candidates for a college degree at that institution.

Credit is also not generally awarded if the course received both high school and college credit. If your class falls under that criterion, please speak to the Office of Academic Services about your situation.

If the home institution verifies the courses using the Verification form (found above).

Peabody College usually does not award credit for work at other colleges in the summer immediately

preceding the student's first semester at Vanderbilt. Summer work elsewhere will be accepted for credit

only if an unusual educational opportunity can be demonstrated and if the courses sought are as rigorous as courses offered at Vanderbilt.
